PARK RULES

- Parks are open from dawn to dusk, unless approved by Village Administrator.
- Only leashed pets are permitted (6 ft. leash maximum).
- Pet owners are required to remove and dispose of their pet's waste.
- Overnight parking, camping and golfing are prohibited unless approved by Village Administrator.
- Use of firearms, fireworks, BB guns, archery equipment, sling shots and paint guns are prohibited.
- A permit is required for athletic activities not affiliated with the Groveport Parks & Recreation Department.
- Illegal and inappropriate conduct will not be tolerated.
- Amplified sound shall not interfere with other visitors, with the exception of Village sponsored or permitted events.
- All local, state and federal ordinances apply.

POND RULES

- Boating, swimming, ice fishing, ice skating and walking on ice is prohibited, unless approved by Village Administrator.
- Persons 16 years of age and older must catch and release fish.
- Any bass or catfish under 16 inches in length must be released.
- Feeding of wildlife is prohibited.

LEISURE PATH RULES

General

- All Village Codes and State Ordinances will be enforced
- No motorized vehicles
- 15 mph speed limit
- Keep right, pass on the left
- Give an audible signal when passing
- Yield when entering and crossing path
- Be courteous and predictable
- Do not block the path
- Pets must be walked off of the path on a 6-foot maximum leash
- Clean up after your pet
- Alcohol is prohibited
- Dispose of litter in receptacle

Pedestrians and Runners

- Watch for other path users and listen for audible signals
- Allow faster users to pass safely

Cyclists and Skaters

- Maintain safe speed and yield right of way to pedestrians
- Slow down in congested or reduced visibility conditions
- Give audible signal when passing
- Ride single file
